What does my child need to play?

Each child should bring a water bottle, shin guards, a ball (size 3 for 4-7 year olds and size 4 for 8-10 year olds and either tennis shoes or soccer cleats. A mouth guard is suggested but is not required unless your child has orthodontia.

What is the total cost for the season?

The cost of the season is \$50 for 7 practices and 7 games. We will have no fundraisers.

What do we get for the money?

7 practices and 7 games, a uniform, team and individual photos, trophies, certificates and a gift bag (at the last game). We also provide snacks and drinks at each practice and game. Please notify us if your child has a food allergy. All children will receive the same snack and drink and no substitutions other than those that are allergy related and noted before the first practice. After the last game we will have a pitch-in picnic and pass out the awards to all the kids. We ask the families attending to provide a large side and two 2-liters of a drink. The league will provide hot dogs, buns, condiments and paper goods.

How many children can play?

Registration is limited! We only have 8 children on a team. We have filled all the spaces in recent seasons. Registration is over when there are no longer spaces available. We can not guarantee that your child will play on a certain team or with a special friend or friends. Team assignments do not depend on carpools because all the children play and practice at the same time. We will attempt to accommodate requests and try to put siblings on the same team if they are in the same division.

Cancellation Policy

It is our policy to only cancel soccer if there is heavy rain or whenever there is thunder or lightning. Sometimes after a heavy rain the fields are flooded and we have to cancel as well. Frequently this decision can only be made at the last minute and there isn't time to contact players before the practice or game. Please contact your coach if the weather is questionable. Please **do not** call the church because no one will be here to take the message. The decision to cancel is based on the weather and condition of the fields.
